COURSE INFORMATION SHEET

Project Title	ITALIAN LANGUAGE – LEVEL A1
Training Objectives	The course aims to provide learners with basic communication skills in Italian, corresponding to QCER Level A1, enabling them to: • understand and use familiar everyday expressions; • interact in a simple way in predictable contexts; • manage immediate communication needs related to daily, social, and work life; • increase personal autonomy and access to employment and training opportunities.
Course Content	Welcome, initial literacy and contact language: • Italian alphabet and basic sounds • Basic pronunciation and intonation • Numbers (0–100) • Greetings and polite expressions • Introducing oneself: name, origin, spoken language Daily life and immediate needs: • Definite and indefinite articles • Gender and number of nouns • Present tense of common verbs (to be, to have, to do, to go) • Vocabulary: home, family, food, leisure • Days, months, time Work orientation and basic language safety: • Basic work-related vocabulary (places, roles, tools) • Expressions for asking for clarification • Simple instructions and procedures • Signs and notices • Essential safety vocabulary (danger, obligation, prohibition) Services, local area and citizenship: • Vocabulary related to services (healthcare, school, transport, offices) • Filling in simple forms • Asking for and giving directions • Using the phone and writing short messages • Basic rights and duties (in simplified language form)
Minimum Entry Requirements	FORMAL REQUIREMENTS: Completion of compulsory education and the right-duty to education and training, regardless of employment status, and residence or domicile in the Emilia-Romagna Region prior to enrollment. SUBSTANTIVE REQUIREMENTS: Knowledge of Italian corresponding to PRE-A1 level of the CEFR, assessed through a structured entry test.
Participation Procedures	Applications will be reviewed in chronological order. The course will be activated based on actual demand and upon reaching a minimum of 8 eligible participants who have applied.

Professional Profile	The course provides skills to communicate in spoken and written Italian at QCER Level A1. At the end of the course, participants will be granted access to an exam at a certification body recognized by the relevant Ministries, leading to an official certification of Italian language proficiency at A1 level, valid under current regulations.

Duration	80 hours
Number of Participants	Minimum 8 – Maximum 15
Delivery Mode	Courses may be delivered either in person—at training centers across the provinces of Piacenza, Parma, Reggio Emilia, Modena, Ferrara, Bologna, Ravenna, Rimini, and Cesena—or online via live (synchronous) videoconferencing. Upon specific request from one or more participants, in-person attendance at the designated training locations will be guaranteed.
